NARRACORTE. September 16. An old resident of the district, **Mrs. Finlay McInnes**, died on Sunday morning at the age of 83. The deceased lady was born in the Isle of Coll, Scotland, and came to Australia in the ship Marmion, landing at Portland in 1852. With her husband, who predeceased her, she came to Naracoorte in 1854, and had resided here ever since. During the past twelve years she had been invalided, but she only became seriously ill about four weeks ago. She leaves a son and a daughter, the latter being Miss J. E. McInnes, librarian at the institute. Twelve grandchildren and four great grand-children also survive her.
