OBITUARY.

MRS. ISABELLA CAMERON.

Narracoorte, November 18.

In the death of **Mrs. Isabella Cameron**, relict of the late Mr. Angus Cameron, the district has lost another of the few pioneer residents who are still among us. The deceased lady had enjoyed good health, till within the last three years, and she passed peacefully away at the residence of her daughter (Mrs. A. Hepburn) at midnight on Monday.

Her maiden name was Isabella McDougall, and she was a daughter of the late Mr. and Mrs. John and Sarah McDougall, being born in the Isle of Coll, Scotland, in the year 1848. She came to Tasmania with her parents in the ship *Persia* in the year 1858, and from there they went to Melbourne, where they remained for a short period. Thence they journeyed to Portland, and on to Penola, residing at the latter place for some little time.

Shortly after the deceased lady's father selected land at Lake Ormond, and she came with her parents to reside in this district. The late Mrs. Cameron had resided here ever since. She married the late Mr. Angus Cameron, who died in 1909, and the issue of the marriage was a family of three daughters and seven sons, two of the sons being deceased. She was a sister of the late Mrs. F. McInnes.
