Goulburn Evening Penny Post (NSW)

Tuesday 20 September 1904:

Another old resident, in the person of **Mr. Hugh McKinnon**, of Bellevue-street, North Goulburn, died on Saturday at the age of 60 years. The deceased was a native of Isle of Coll, Argyllshire, Scotland, and came to this State at the age of 14 years. Some time after he settled in the Taralga district and since that time he had lived in and around Goulburn. His residence in the city extended over a period of 20 years. Mr. McKinnon leaves a widow and six children, two sons and four daughters. The sons are Mr. Charles McKinnon, of Goulburn, and Mr. Hugh McKinnon, of Murrumburrah. The deceased gentleman is survived by three brothers and one sister. The brothers are Mr. Lachlan and Mr. Neil McKinnon, of Taralga, and Mr. John McKinnon, of Young. Mrs. Hector Sinclair, of Dick's Flat, Taralga, is a sister.
